1. Class composition

No rider is permitted to compete outside of his age or gender group.

2. Seeding and Transfer system

- Heat for Elite and Junior are determined by UCI ranking, National ranking
- Gate selection uses UCI Part 6 BMX Annex 2
- For challenge class, heats will be determined by scrambled position and gate selection will be determined by random for 1st round only, 2nd and 3rd round gate position determined by previous round position

3. Race numbers

- The international permanent race number of the rider must be used in this competition.
- A rider without permanent race number will be assigned a random number.

4. Number plates

The stickers number plate will be provided by the organizer.

- 5. All riders are required to wear fullface helmet with visor min 10cm long.
- 6. Camera permitted on training only, non bolt fix on helmet
- 7. Jersey regulation priorities will be applied, non conformity jersey will result on refusal of start.

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


	 There are 4 straights. The second one is separate in two lines: Challenge section. Pro section.

A passport valid for 6 months beyond the dates of travel is required. Foreigner nationals must apply for a visa on the Indonesia embassy of their countries. Foreign nationals who want to participate in the race, must communicate with Indonesia embassy in their countries how to get an Indonesian visa during Covid-19 pandemic.

19. COVID-19 PANDEMI

All people in the venue are must follow strictly the health protocol issued by government.

No Spectators allowed.

Rider and official will be isolated during the events and wil beswab antigen on site. Youth Centre hostel is designated

Swab Antigen is mandatory for everyone in the venue and must be shown to the safety officer.

Foreign nationals who want to participate in the race, must communicate with Indonesia embassy in their countries how to get an Indonesian visa during Covid-19 pandemic.

RT-PCR health test requirements

The health test requirements for all travellers travelling from abroad, as follows:

- 3 x 24 hours before departure;
- 1 x 24 hours after arrival in the Republic of Indonesia; and
- 5 x 24 hours after arrival/isolation at the accommodation in Indonesia.

Isolation requirements

- 5 x 24 hours after arrival/isolation at the accommodation in Indonesia
- After 5 x 24 hours of self-isolation and hotel isolation, all international travelers **are encouraged** to undertake self-isolation at their respective residence up until a total of 14 days after arrival in the Republic of Indonesia.

Travel Corridor Arrangement

Arrangements for foreign nationals originating from countries with TCA bilateral scheme with the Republic of Indonesia, shall be performed **according to the arrangement of the TCA scheme** by abiding with strict health protocol.
